2015 Senior Games / Golf Information

Golf is a sport played by millions of people. The goal is to hit a golf ball from the teeing area to the green via the fairway and get the ball in the hole on the green in as few of strokes as possible. Golf is traditionally 18 holes and most often is played as an individual sport. Team sports include <u>Best Ball</u>; where two players play their own ball from teeing area to green and the lowest individual score is the team score for that hole and <u>Scramble</u>; where two player both hit a shot from the same place and then select the players ball that is in the best position and play the next shot from that position, continuing until the ball is holed on the green.

Golf can be played by all ages simply by adjusting the length that a player must play between tee and green. In most cases, the longer the course, the harder the game. Most golf facilities ask players to play in 4 ½ hours or less. During this tournament we will be monitoring and enforcing this rule to ensure that we don't disrupt others that may be behind us.

The Senior Summer Games Golf Competition will be broken down to two divisions – beginner and advanced. Please choose the division that best suits you to ensure that everyone has a great time. It is the player's responsibility to provide their own partner. In the event that you don't have a partner, we will try to pair you up. Rental clubs will be available at the course for an additional fee.

BEGINNER DIVISION / 2 person team / Scramble Format / Special Tees – players in this division have limited experience playing golf. Players in this division will play from a set of forward tees commonly referred to as Family Tees. Each player in a two person team will "tee off" and the best shot of the two players will be selected. From that new position, both players will hit a shot from within one club length of the original shot and the team will pick the best of those shots, and then play from that shot. Play will continue in this format until the ball is in the hole or until the team has hit a total of seven (7) shots. Once a team has hit seven (7) shots, they should pick up their balls and move to the next teeing area and record 7 as the score for that hole. Scoring will be based on the Stableford System – shots over 7 will neither help nor hurt the team score.

Teams may be man-man, man-woman or woman-woman. All players will play from the same forward tees. Teams will be broken down into age groups based on the lowest age of the two players. The winner will be the team with the lowest team score in their age group at completion of play.

ADVANCED DIVISION / 2 person team / Best Ball Format / Men from the silver tees – Women from the red tees – players in this division should have some experience playing golf on their own. Men will play from the silver tees and women from the red tees. Each player will play their own ball to the completion of the hole. Once a player reaches double bogey (two (2) over par) they should pick up and move to the next hole. The team score will be the lowest individual hole score for the two players. Scoring will be based on the Stableford System – shots over double bogey will neither help nor hurt the team score.

Teams may be man-man, man-woman or woman-woman. Teams <u>may</u> be separated by team composition depending on number and type of entries. Teams <u>will</u> be broken down into age groups based on the lowest age of the two players. The winning team will be the team with the lowest gross score in their age group at completion of play.

Registration Information, Process and Location

Registration Forms: A completed registration form and full payment must be received by the following deadlines to ensure entry into the games. Registration opens June 15, 2015. Mailed entries must be postmarked by Friday, August 7, 2015. Deadline for drop-off entries is Monday, August 10, 2015. Any entries received after the deadlines will be considered on an individual basis and are not guaranteed entry into the games. **Please complete entry forms in full – both pages!** Incomplete or incorrect entry forms may result in a participant not being included in a sport.

Check-In: Prior to your first scheduled event, you must check in at the Senior Services Office which is located at the Evelyn Mount Northeast Community Center, 1301 Valley Road, Reno, NV 89512, on the second floor (775-657-4602). Each individual must check-in personally. A photo ID showing your date of birth will be required. At check-in you will sign your participation waiver and then receive your Contestant ID (bib), Closing Ceremonies Luncheon/Dance Ticket, Official Games Shirt and Welcome Bag. Participants who have not checked-in prior to their event will not be allowed to play.

Check-in hours: Saturday, August 15, 2015, 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm, immediately following the Opening Ceremonies. Beginning Monday, August 17, 2015, check-in will be available weekdays at the Senior Services Office on Valley Road, from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM daily.

Participant / Partner Age: All athletes must be 50 years old by August 1, 2015. Athlete's age will be based on his/her age on August 1, 2015. Partner age groups are determined by the age of the youngest partner on August 1, 2015.

Age Divisions: (unless otherwise stated on individual sport page)

Individuals / Partners: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-99, 100+ Games officials reserve the right to cancel any event or combine age divisions due to low entries.

Equipment: In most sports, participants are required to provide their own equipment. Some sports have equipment for rent or use. Please contact Senior Services for details – (775) 657-4602 or SeniorServices@reno.gov.

Medals: Medals will be presented after an event unless indicated on sports page. Any medals not picked up at presentations may be picked up at the Senior Services Office at the Evelyn Mount Northeast Community Center or at the Closing Ceremonies Luncheon/Dance, No medals will be mailed.

Engraving: Next day engraving on medals will be available for a nominal fee. Please ask at the Senior Services Office for contact information and price.

USING THE ONLINE REGISTRATION FORMS

TO COMPLETE FORMS BY HAND:

- Print the blank forms and write-in all requested information
- Completed forms may be either mailed or hand-delivered to any of our sites

TO COMPLETE FORMS WITH KEYBOARD:

- Click into first field (Last Name), type name, then tab to next field (First Name)
- Continue, until both forms have been filled out (including Sports Form)
- Click File:Save As (upper left corner) to begin the save process. A dialog box will appear; rename the form with your first-and-last name (eg: John Smith). You will not need to change the file type i.e. you will leave as <u>.pdf</u>. Select "desktop" from menu on the left. Click [Save] and your document will now appear on your desktop.
- Open a blank email addressed to <u>SeniorServices@reno.gov</u>. Type "SSG Entry Forms" and your name in the subject bar, then attach your saved forms. You are welcome to include a note in your email.
