

Ladies,

The Board of the Sierra Sage Women's Golf Club has made a decision to start up event play. These events will need to follow criteria that meet the Golf Directive that Governor Sisolak sent to all Nevada golf courses on April 29, 2020.

***We realize this is a lot of information but ask that you read all of it before participating in this first event.***

Details:

- ***Golf only. No congregating before or after play. Food and Beverage will be available.***
- Tee times will start at 8:00 am and go until approximately 10:00am.
- Golfers will pay their green fees, cart, and (optional play day fee) the day of our weekly events.
- Carts - The Governor's Directive specifically says "only one rider per cart unless they are from the same household".
- Scoring - Scorecards will be in the pro shop to be handed out there. Upon completion of play, there will be a drop box for your scorecards. We ask that you keep your own score and a competitor's. There will NOT be a scorecard exchange but your score and your competitors scores must match at the end of the round, so please read the scores off to each other as a check.
- There will be no closest to the pin contests.

## **What you can do to help yourself and everyone else that plays in our events:**

- No high fives and 18 hole handshakes or hugs...try an elbow, foot bump or golf club tap.
- Putt with the flagstick in. Cups are inverted, do NOT touch the flag.
- Find extra space in your golf bag for hand sanitizer and use it frequently.
- Keep your distance from groups outside your own and remember "social distancing" of at least 6 feet.
- Please don't tee it up if you feel sick. If you've already checked in and are not feeling well, we'll refund your fees. We all love the game, but don't put someone else at risk.
- Keep your cellphone where it's not directly on the cart dashboard or cubby. Keep your phone on person and wipe it down frequently.
- We prefer that you walk and if not that you ride as a single.
- Please don't "hang out" at the Pro Shop or The Pub. Check in and then wait outside for your tee time unless you are eating in the restaurant. Always keep your distance from other golfers.
- Please don't wet your golf towels in the rest rooms. There will be a bucket of water with sanitizer on the first and tenth tees. Dip your towel in the sanitized water and ring it out...please don't put your hands in the water.

***The health and safety of our members is our single highest priority.*** We'll continue to watch the coronavirus crisis with the intention of doing what's right for the safety of all of us. We truly appreciate your help and understanding during this very difficult time.

We realize that this isn't our normal presentation, but to meet the Golf Directive of the Governor, this is the only way we can have events.
