

SSGC Pace of Play Policy Implementation Plan

1. Tournament Director/Designee will forward the following to the field with the tournament tee sheet via e-mail:
 - a. Pace of Play Policy
 - b. SSMC Recommendations for Improving Pace of Play
 - c. Rules of Golf Penalty Relief – 2020
 - d. SSGC Penalty Areas
2. Any exceptional delays or gaps need to be noted by the Starter/Designee on the first tee.
3. As group(s) finish the 18th hole, they need to sign and turn in score cards directly without delay. Tournament Director/Designee will note the time card was received (on individual score cards or official tee sheet).
4. At conclusion of the tournament, the finish times will be provided to the Pace of Play Chair/Designee.
5. Any individual(s)/group(s) identified exceeding established metrics will be notified per policy.
6. Any member penalized (tee time restricted) by exceeding policy may request an audience with the Pace of Play Committee to present their case.
