New Business:

1. Sarah discussed all of the protocols put in place to protect us all from Co-vid 19 virus. They were discussed in an e-mail sent out by the course on April 30, 2020.
2. The Board agreed that we would start our season June 2nd. If there are members who do not wish to play this year and want a refund of dues, please let Patti know. There will be no shotgun starts this season. Tee times start at 8AM through 10AM. Sign ups for the first day should be made by calling, e-mailing or texting Debbie Schwoyer. After this first week you will sign up at the course. Debbie said she will rotate the first 5 tee times slots each week. There will be no closest to the pin this season but we will still put \$5 in the pot for - \$4 for sweeps and \$1 for chip-ins. There will be no Coyote Invitational this year and our end of the year luncheon is tentative. Guests are still always welcome but they cannot participate in the weekly buy-in monies. Since we can't have our opening breakfast it was decided to give everyone a sack with a muffin and maybe a fruit and drink before they start their round. This will also be done a couple of times during the season. As far as posting is concerned, there is an app for smart phones which can be used – USGA-Ghin. Debbie will post for those who cannot use the app.
